Subject	Skills Taught	How can you help?
English	<p>Writing in a number of different genres both Fiction and Non-Fiction.</p> <p>Presenting ideas to the class, drama and retelling stories.</p> <p>Reading books in a group and predicting, questioning,</p>	<p>Encourage children to practise their sentence writing at home. Ensure children are using capital letters and full stops.</p> <p>Ask children to share what they have learnt with you during the week.</p> <p>Read a range of books at home, including traditional tales. Compare the books to Disney films.</p>
Maths	<p>Place Value</p> <p>Counting</p> <p>Addition</p> <p>Subtraction</p> <p>Times tables</p> <p>Multiplication</p> <p>Division</p>	<p>Ask children to count in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's at home. Try counting as you climb the stairs!</p> <p>Help children to practise reciting their times tables.</p> <p>Ask children to show you the new methods we learn in school.</p>
Science	<p>Rocks, Soils and Fossils</p> <p>Animals (including humans)</p>	<p>When out and about look out for rocks and soils and discuss whether they are natural or man-made.</p> <p>Whilst cooking, discuss healthy food and what we need to survive and grow.</p>
Computing	<p>Powerpoint</p> <p>Word processing</p> <p>Research</p>	<p>If possible, practise typing on a computer.</p> <p>Investigate our topics further by doing some research to answer any questions the children have about what we are learning.</p>
History	<p>Kings and Queens</p> <p>Children now and then (WW2)</p>	<p>Go to the library or research on the internet and explore these topics.</p>
Geography	<p>Place Knowledge of Castles in the UK</p> <p>Frozen lands, designing frozen fantasy world</p>	<p>Go to the library or research on the internet and explore these topics.</p>
Religious Education	<p>Chronological theme of changing power of monarchs</p>	<p>Go to the library or research on the internet and explore these topics.</p>
French	<p>Greetings and Animals</p>	<p>Associate actions with new words learnt and practise them.</p>
Art Design & Technology	<p>Designing Castles</p> <p>Stained glass windows</p>	<p>Have some fun creative time at home and have fun drawing and designing castles. Look around town for any stained glass windows.</p>
Personal, Social & Health Education	<p>Teamwork</p> <p>Getting to know each other</p> <p>Bullying</p>	<p>Speak to your children about any issues arising at school and work through problems together with class teacher.</p>
